The IHA has a history of supporting juniors with scholarships, and the Prospect awards will give additional opportunities to support younger members. If there is no applicant for a grade level, no award will be given. The winner in each grade level will receive an appropriate award.

Requirements:

1. Applicant must be an active member of the Illinois Junior Hereford Association.
2. Applicant must be in the 6th, 7th or 8th grade on June 1st of the applying year.
3. Applicant may receive the award only once per division.

Process:

1. Read through the entire application before you begin. Start at the beginning and proceed through the entire form answering questions on a clean sheet of paper. Applications can be handwritten in ink or typed. Use whatever space you need to answer the questions to their fullest.
2. If a question does not apply to you personally, please designate as such. Please do not worry if you can't answer all the questions just include as much information as possible.
3. Each applicant must submit one recent photograph.
4. Mail one copy of the application.
